They agreed that they were provided with ample learning opportunities to challenging tasks. The team of students who took part in the PolyU Science Young Talents Competition said they were being intellectually stimulated during the whole process, from training till the end of competition. They needed to apply their prior knowledge, to think critically and to resolve problems on their way. Engaging in such activities pushed them to go beyond their comfort zones and expand their abilities. Students who have participated in the learning programs also believed they</li></ul>

					<p>could grow from receiving feedback from different people, especially experts from that particular field, like Biology or Chemistry. Constructive feedback helped the students identify their strengths and weaknesses, refine skills (such as problem-solving, leadership and communication skills) and hence further develop their talents. In face of difficulties and rigorous environment, resilience, discipline and perseverance were built in students. Discovering and understanding themselves more, a sense of achievement and ownership in learning was nurtured, students also had higher self-esteem and were encouraged to set more ambitious goals.</p>
