Over 95% of students had	\$43,732

					increased sense of self-achievement. More than 90% of students believed their creativity was fostered and 100% students agreed the programs enabled them to be more resilient. They learnt to view setbacks as opportunities for growth, enhancing self-efficacy. Over 80% of participants believed that the gifted programs facilitated them to have better time management skills. 100% of students concurred that taking part in gifted programs help them with goal-setting and life planning. Students had a better sense of what to pursue in the future and what areas to improve for growth.
