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

Self-understanding and development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Increasing <i>collaboration among functional teams</i> to implement life-planning education programmes in class periods (for all levels) and CLP Periods (for S3 & S6): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - S.1: Developing Self-understanding and career exploration - S.2: Developing generic skills and career exploration - S.3: Learning to make sound decision: smart subject choices - S.4: Career information and mapping - S.5: Understanding multiple pathways and the world of work - S6: Goal setting and making informed choices for post-secondary studies 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ To assist student in achieving better self-understanding ◆ To guide students to explore their personality traits, interests, aptitude, potential, abilities and career direction ◆ To help students to be self-directing in the process of their goal setting, decision-making and reflection ◆ To provide assessment tools to help students to gain better understanding of themselves, expand career options and strengths 	September 2022 to July 2023	\$16,920	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ 96% of students finished CLP structured curriculum in class periods. ◆ Over 85% of students agreed that the programmes were useful and their self-understanding has been enhanced. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For S.1 students, 92% of them expressed that the program was helpful and they had better understanding of themselves after the program. - For S.2 students, 90% of students thought that the program was useful and they were satisfied with it. They learned the importance of self-discipline, self-management and healthy lifestyle after the program. - For S.3 students, 89% of them found the program was useful and they were satisfied with it. It raised their awareness of the need to equip themselves to meet the needs of the ever-changing society. - Over 70% of S3 students gave 4 or 5 (max. 5 marks) on CLP lessons. They deemed that individual consultations in CLP lessons helped them learn how to make a well-informed and more sensible choice of selecting their electives in S4. - For S.4 students, around 90% of them found the program useful and they were satisfied with it. They agreed that they could get better understanding of leadership qualities. - For S.5 students, 89% of them agreed that the programme enabled them to think about setting SMART goals for themselves and the factors to consider when pursuing their dreams. - Over 92% of S6 students expressed that the programme helped them understand more the multiple pathways. - Regarding CLP lessons for S6, over 90% of them gave positive feedback and agreed that the lessons were useful and practical in guiding them to set achievable goals.

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Using tools provided by 'My Life Planning Portfolio' of EDB for Senior form students 		September 2022 to July 2023	\$0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Around 90% of students completed the online assessments. ◆ S4 and S5 students completed the online assessment for career and life planning administered by EDB (<i>My Life Planning Portfolio</i>). 70% of them agreed that the assessment results provided them with a useful reference for their planning and rethinking their future development. ◆ 80% of junior form students who completed the COA test agreed that the tools were effective in enhancing their self-understanding. For S.3 students, 88% of them expressed that the tools were useful in helping them to understand themselves.

Around 93% of student-participants found the training programme very useful and realized the importance of communication and collaboration. They had shown improvement in leadership skills. ◆ Fresh Ambassadors found the training camp rewarding and they could apply the skills learnt in organizing the game booths in school.

Around 80% of student-participants expressed that the programme was useful in enhancing their self-understanding and generic skills.

Rotary Career Expo was held in June. 90% of participants found the event useful in providing them with the up-to-date knowledge, skills and attitude about the world of work and future career paths. Most agreed that it was beneficial to their life planning. All participants in the mentorship programme agreed that the mentors offered them effective guidance to set more realistic goals for their future studies and career. The programme helped them understand better the importance of developing positive attitudes and ethics needed in the workplace, and preparing themselves for their future career development. Over 88% of student-participants agreed that the life-planning activities they joined (e.g. taster lectures, talks and information days run by universities and other organizations) were effective in enriching their knowledge of the post-secondary programmes and facilitating their life planning. Students joining the Work Experience Programmes of EDB and a local medical group remarked that the programmes enabled them to better understand the requirements of employers, enhance generic skills, and develop correct work attitude and values. They found the programmes rewarding. CICE Taster Programmes on making coffee, desserts and aromatherapy were arranged for S.2-S.4 students in June. Most of them gave positive feedback.

They could read the career-related materials during the weekly Reading Period and their spare time. The most up-to-date information was also disseminated via email. By observation, class teachers found that students' awareness of exploring and planning their future has been increased with easier access to career information.

For S.3 students, 86% of students agreed that Talk on S.4 Subject Selection could provide them with useful information and guidelines when choosing Senior Secondary electives. ◆ Over 95% of the parent-participants agreed that Talk on S.4 Subject Selection provided them with useful information on Senior Secondary electives and facilitated their discussion with their children about selecting electives in S.4 ◆ Over 90% of S.6 students expressed Mock Release of HKDSE Examination Results gave them a valuable opportunity to reflect and practise interviewing skills. They generally agreed that the event could help them better prepare for the upcoming admissions interviews and the DSE results release. This year, an English interview session was added. S6 could join on a voluntary basis. Participating students agreed that this session could help boost their confidence in expressing themselves in English. ◆ Career Programme on Jobs conducted by EdVenue was held for S.2 in March 2023. Over 80% of them agreed that it helped enhance their understanding of the entry requirement of the tertiary programmes & the abilities needed for different jobs.

In Nov 2022, a talk was delivered by an official from Hok Yau Club on multiple career pathways for secondary school leavers. Positive feedback was received from teachers in both events. Careers Team members generally agreed that they became more confident in offering career guidance to students.
